"The Cup Song" Instructions

For this technique you need a plastic cup (red solo cups work well but any plastic cup will do). It sounds the best if you do it on a surface with fabric on it.

- 1. Start with the cup sitting upside down on the table.
- 2. Clap your hands 2 times.
- 3. Hit the bottom of the cup 3 times (Right, Left, Right).
- Clap your hands 1 time.
- 5. Pick up the cup and set it down.
- Clap your hands 1 time.
- 7. Turn your left hand over to pick the cup up.
- 8. Hit the top of the cup with your right hand.
- 9. Hit the bottom edge of the cup onto the table.
- 10. Switch the cup from your left hand to your right hand.
- 11. Tap the table with your free left hand.
- 12.Place the cup down with your right hand.

Repeat until the song is over.
